Ex-Soviet Envoy Aid Questioned in Spy Probe
WASHINGTON, Sept. 10 (UP)—An American girl who served as secretary to two Soviet ambassadors was reported today to have been among the witnesses questioned secretly by House espionage investigators.
The girl, described as a Washingtonian, who once worked for former Ambassadors Constantin Oumansky and Andrei Gromyko, was reportedly to have been one of several persons who testified yesterday during an eight-hour session held by a House, Un-American Activities Subcommittee.
Subcommittee members refused to discuss the matter.
Six more witnesses were ordered to appear at another closed session today.
