**4 Bootleg Cab Operators Fined**

**Found Guilty By Judge Clark**  
Four bootleg cab operators were fined by Judge Alex Clark in Municipal Court 4 today. George Campbell, 707 E. 22d St., was fined \$1 and costs and sentenced to five days in jail for operating a taxi without a taxi cab license. He was also found guilty of operating a taxi without a meter and without a taxi operator's license but Judge Clark withheld judgment on these counts.

Cleve O. Bell, 32, of 1519 E. 19th St., was fined \$1 and costs on each of three counts, including operating without a taxi license, without a taxi operator's license and having no meter in the cab. Bell told the court he was an employee of International Harvester Co.

William T. Dalton, 19, of 1006 Udell St., was fined \$1 and costs for operating without a taxi license and for having no meter in his vehicle.

Richard Fleming, 38, of 336 Minerva St., was fined \$1 and costs for operating without a taxi license and the same fine for not having a meter in his vehicle.

Campbell was arrested yesterday. The others were arrested Aug. 22.

**Heavy Forest Fire Loss Feared in State**

Department of Conservation officials feared today that Indiana would suffer a heavy loss from forest fires in the state during the autumn months.

State Forester Ralph Wilcox said that due to unusually heavy vegetation this summer, he anticipated a bad fire season when the grass, trees and underbrush become dry this fall.

Some 329 fires burned 10,074 acres between Jan. 1 and July 1 this year at a loss of \$41,404, Mr. Wilcox said.

Conservation officials planned to train some 850 southern Indiana high school boys as firefighters in the next few months, he said.

**'A' Auto Plates, New License Look Due in State**

"A" LICENSE plates soon will appear on Indiana highways, Secretary of State Thomas E. Bath announced today.

For the first time, the number of car licenses issued will pass the million mark, he said, and it will be necessary to start the use of letter-numeral combinations. The first combination number, probably to be issued next week, will be A-10001.

Reason for the change is that Indiana plates are not wide enough to carry clearly legible numbers above a million. By 1950, he said, the letter-number combination plates will completely replace the present plates carrying numbers only and the "star" plates issued to state officials and

certain others will be eliminated. plates to increase visibility at night, establishment of a permanent color combination and use of semi-permanent plates which will last from three to five years instead of having to be change annually.

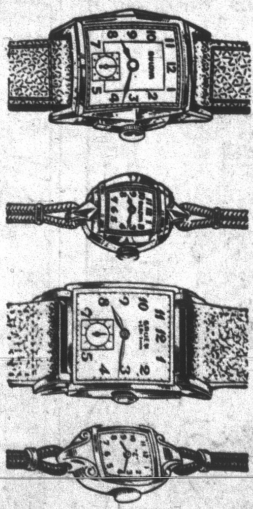
