Candidates Trade Verbal Crossfire

Jacobs, Denny Hurl Campaign Barbs

A cross-fire of questions and answers today featured the closing campaign battles between the two Marion County candidates for Congress.

Democratic Candidate Andrew Jacobs accused his Republican opponent, George L. Denny, of failing to answer several pertinent questions on the issues.

Mr. Denny retorted hotly that he wasn't answering some of his opponent's questions because they are "violations of the old rule of law that forbids a question which assumes a fact not already proven like: 'Have you stopped beating your wife?'"

Answer on Veto Power Mr. Jacobs asked: "What does Mr. Denny propose to do about eliminating the veto power which Russia has handed off to the United Nations?"

Mr. Denny said he proposes to "do nothing about that for the very good reason that the House of Representatives has no constitutional authority in such a matter. If my opponent will take the trouble he will find that such instruments are the responsibility of the President with the consent of two-thirds of the Senate. As I understand it we are not running for the Senate."

Asks About Deficit Mr. Jacobs challenged Mr. Denny about the \$800,000 city deficit he (Mr. Denny) left when he was mayor.

"The answer to that is that it is not true," Mr. Denny said. "And I can prove it if proof were necessary."

Then Mr. Jacobs charged that his opponent when Mayor signed a "zoning ordinance thinking it was an appropriation ordinance."

"To say that I confused a zoning ordinance with an appropriation of ridiculous," Mr. Denny said. "Where my opponent got such an idea I will never be able to understand."

Mr. Denny didn't answer for the present his opponent's question about the bad features of the Taft-Hartley Act which Mr. Denny says he will try to change.
