## Scientist Reports Early Relics Found

NEW YORK, Nov. 22—When ice gripped the earth about 50,000 years ago, California was inhabited by some sort of human beings.

The remains of fires, tools and discarded shells of many ancient dinners have been found in shore deposits near what is now La Jolla, the Geological Society of America was told here by Dr. George F. Carter, geologist of Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Md.

When these La Jolla men lived the sea level was lower than now and now the ocean is rapidly eroding the buried evidence of these very early Californians whose skeletons have not yet been discovered.
