## Oral Traylor Rites

## To Be Held Saturday

Oral Traylor, of near Nineveh, Ind., AFL Glazier Union local business agent and widely known Hoosier fox hunter, died today in Johnson County Memorial Hospital after an illness of two months. He was 56.

Born in Ottwell, Ind., Mr. Traylor lived in the Nineveh community all his life. For the past three years he had been business agent for Glazier Union, Local No. 1165, AFL. He was a member of Traylor Chapel, Ottwell, the Indiana and Southern Fox Hunters Association and the Brown County Fox Hunters Association.

Mr. Traylor had a long record of service in the glass industry. He had worked for the Pittsburgh Glass Co., Stewart Carey Glass Co., Capital Glass Co., Syndicate Glass Co., and the Edward S. Lammers Glass Co. of Terre Haute.

Besides his wife, Annabelle, he

is survived by two sons, Doyle A. Traylor, Russell, Kas., and Norman Traylor, Indianapolis; a daughter, Mrs. Agatha M. Tennant, Indianapolis; two brothers, DeWitt Traylor, Indianapolis, and William Patton, Bakersfield, Cal.; two sisters, Mrs. Nona Hance, and Mrs. Demie Dillon, Indianapolis, and two grandchildren.

Services at 10 a. m. Saturday in Shirley Brothers Central Chapel will be followed by burial in Floral Park.

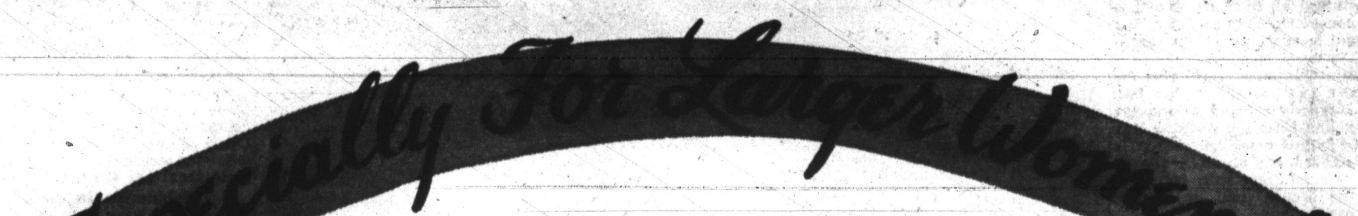
