## 300 Feared Dead,

## 360 Hurt in Wall Collapse

LISBON, Feb. 21 (UPI)—Reporters from Praia, in the Cape Verde Islands, said today that 300 persons were feared dead in the collapse of a huge stone wall on a bridge containing hundreds of indigents.

The wall was 22 feet high and more than 90 feet long. At least 360 persons were injured in addition to those killed. Rescue gangs were reported still digging in the crumbled masonry in search of survivors.
