3 Methodist Clerics to Visit Reich

Goodwill Group To Leave Mar. 10 For 6-Week Trek

Methodists of Indianapolis and the state will send three goodwill ambassadors to Germany next week.

Three young Methodist ministers from the denomination's three conferences in the state will preach and visit for six weeks in Germany as part of the worldwide "Methodist Advance for Christ and His Church."

The Rev. Elmer Harvey, former assistant pastor of the Broadway Methodist Church, here, now pastor of the Wall Street Church in Jeffersonville, will go from the Indiana Conference.

Sail Mar. 10
The Rev. Donald Bailey, pastor of the Goshen Methodist Church, will go from the North Indiana Conference. And the Rev. Samuel Carruth, pastor of the Centenary Methodist Church, here, now pastor of the Wall Street Church in Jeffersonville, will go from the Indiana Conference.

The Rev. Mr. Harvey will travel first in England and the other will go through France to Germany.

Food packages have been sent on for their meals while in Germany. They and their congregations have assembled quite an array of articles such as chocolate, soap, nylon and the like for the young ministers to carry in their luggage and give to children and the needy overseas.

All three men will visit various cities in Germany but do not intend to try to get into the Russian zone nor have they permission to enter Berlin.

"Return Courtesy"
Last summer Bishop Richard C. Raines of the Indiana Methodist Area traveled in Germany and was deeply impressed with the evidences of destruction. He requested the head of the Methodist denomination, there, Bishop Ernst J. W. Sommer, to come to Indiana this winter and tour the state and speak.

This Bishop Sommer did. As a result, the three Indiana ministers will "return the courtesy."

The Indiana Area has assumed the responsibility of rebuilding three Methodist institutions in Germany as their Advance project. These are the Mary and Martha Deaconess Hospital in Nuremberg, the Methodist Theological Seminary and a Printing establishment, both in Frankfurt. There are 60,000 Methodists in Germany and many other institutions.

The Rev. Mr. Carruth struck the keynote of the purpose of the goodwill tours when he said: "I hope our personal ministry always will have an international accent after our return."

Winter Wheat Aided by Weather

Danger to Fruit Crop Reported by Bureau

WASHINGTON, Mar. 3—Another week that started with mild, thawing weather and ended in a cold wave bowed out February and ushered in March, with the threat of floods still unrealized and still more of the snow cover liquidated, U. S. Weather Bureau field observers report.

There were widespread rains and snows, but not enough to cause serious trouble on many rivers.

The thoroughly soaked soil gives promise of another good winter-wheat crop. Grain fields, as well as pastures, are greening as far north as Nebraska and the lower Great Lakes region.

The one disturbing feature in the picture is the fruit crop, especially the peaches. Many fruit trees in the Southeast were encouraged into premature flowering by the mild weather of late winter, only to be caught by the present cold wave. It is still too early, weather bureau men stated, to estimate possible damage done during the past three nights.

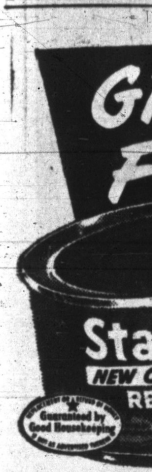
