### Two Murals To Be Unveiled Wednesday At Tech By Principal Anderson

Two murals by J. Scott Williams, nationally known muralist, will be unveiled Wednesday in Technical High School.

H. H. Anderson, principal, will introduce guests to 146 roll room representatives in the tower of Milo H. Stuart Memorial Hall and present the murals to the School Board.

One mural shows the Arsenal at Tech during Civil War days, while the other portrays student activities after the school was opened in the early 1900's. They were financed through donations by various school organizations.

Students in sponsor rooms will hear proceedings over Tech's public address system, beginning at 11 a. m. with a prelude of carillon music by Frederic Barker. The Girls' Ensemble and Boys' Octette will sing after the presentation.
