## Women Aid Lenten Loyalty Drive

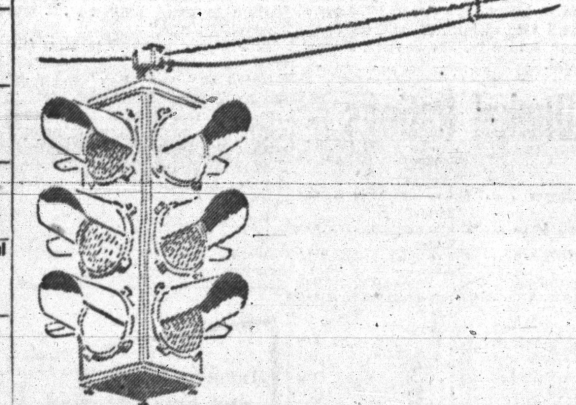

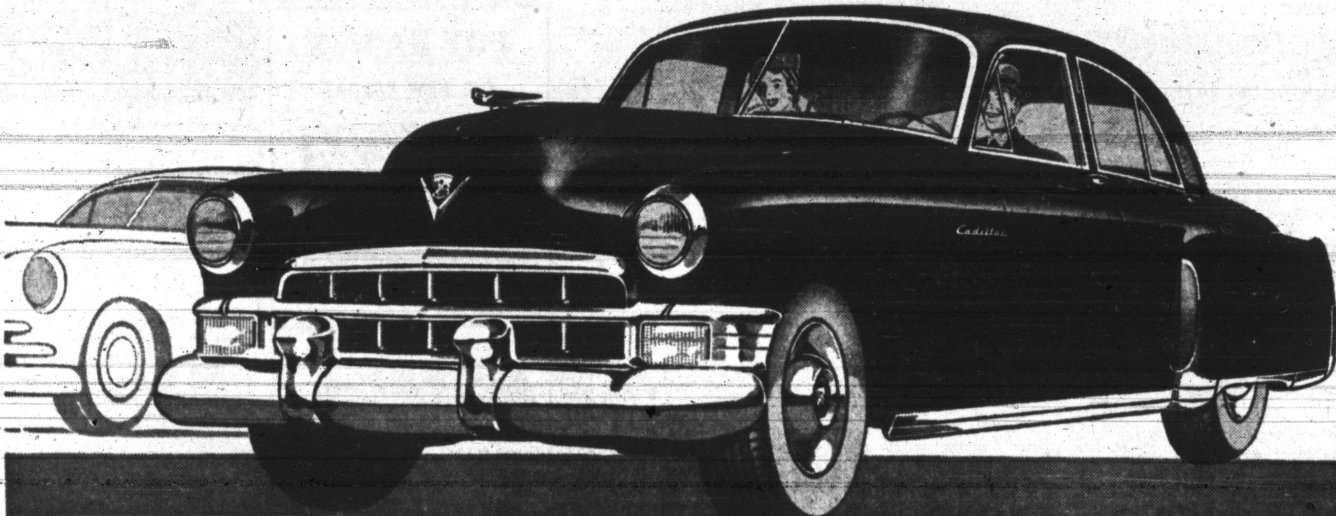
