

**Aetna '48 Assets
Near \$1.5 Billion**

**State General Agent
Issues Report**

Assets of the Aetna Life Insurance Co. came within a whisker of the \$1.5 billion mark at the end of 1948, Paul M. Williams, CLU, general agent in Southern Indiana, announced today.

Mr. Williams' office in the Merchants Bank Bldg. reported \$40,965,534 in new paid business and an increase in personal accident premiums for the year. Total group volume has doubled since 1945 when he took the agency.

Aetna, he reported, covers large corporations and utilities in the area.

The company showed liabilities of \$1,385,585,012 with a contingency reserve of \$41 million, capital of \$15 million and surplus of \$58,222,010.

The company's statement showed the accumulative payment of \$2,461,368,632 to policyholders and an increase in life insurance in force during 1948 of \$697,019,728. Insurance in force at the close of December totaled \$7,682,601,807.
