



Hospital Care For Veterans Under Probe

Ruling Sought From Congress On GI Rights

WASHINGTON, Mar. 31—Congress is wrestling with the problem of how far the government should go in providing medical care to veterans for ailments not related to their military service.

The problem is before the Senate Labor and Public Welfare Committee. For several days members have been hearing complaints from towns and cities affected by the recent cutback in the veterans' hospital construction program.

Because Congress had authorized more hospitals than the Veterans Administration could staff, 24 hospitals still in the blueprint stage were eliminated and 14 others reduced in size.

Each city's delegation tells the same story. It wants its own hospital constructed according to the original plan. It is sure enough doctors and nurses can be found to staff it.

Core of Problem
Carefully skirted by some of the participants is the core of the problem. This, according to the Veterans Administration, is the question of what is the proper limit to the government's obligation to its ex-servicemen.

Officials of veterans' organizations, who are working with the local delegations, take the position that the government owes free medical care to all veterans. They brush aside the distinction between service-connected and non-service-connected cases.

Congress has never said flatly that the government must provide free medical care to all sick veterans. The legal expression is that the government must take care of service-connected cases and can take care of others—if hospital beds are available and the veteran lacks funds to pay.


