



Last-Minute Entry Possible In Times Spelling Bee

Contestants May Sign Up at Centers
Until Elimination Begins Tomorrow

The entry list for The Times Spelling Bee still will be open to all grammar school pupils when the speldown starts tomorrow at 7:30 p. m. at six centers.

Although no more mail entries will be accepted, those who have not sent in their entries may sign up at the center where their school is listed to spell.

No new entries will be accepted at any center after the first preliminary at that center has been held.

Every grammar school pupil is eligible as long as he or she has not passed beyond the eighth grade and will not be 18 years old before June 1.

The official word list will be made up from regular school spellers used by all grades. Contestants who survive the first preliminary will return to their centers the week of Apr. 18 for the second preliminary. At the second preliminary the field will be narrowed to two contestants who will represent their district in the semifinals with contestants from the semidistricts in the first week of May.

County Schools Entered

County school pupils now are competing in speldowns in their schools to select two winners to take part in a township final. The winners from each township will take part in the first semifinals with contestants from the semidistricts in Indianapolis.

The Indianapolis champion, who could be a pupil from a county school, will go to Washington, D. C. to take part in the National Spelling Bee. The Indianapolis champion would win \$500 for first place in the national final. He or she will win at least \$40 in cash in the national final. All expenses for the trip to Washington and the week's stay will be paid by The Times.

Aided by City

The staff of the City Park and Recreation Department will be in charge of the speldowns at the centers. The park department annually co-operates with The Times in staging the spelling bee.
