

# House Burns, Woman's Cry Routs Tenants

## Apartment Building Occupants Escape as Roomer Gives Alarm

An unidentified woman rooming in the Harold Apartments, 1701 College Ave., last night aroused all the building residents, enabling all to get out safely when fire destroyed an attic apartment and the roof.

The woman, who roomed on the second floor of the two-and-a-half-story brick structure, awakened, smelled smoke and ran through the halls screaming "fire." She called the Fire Department at 11:29 p. m. but by the time firemen arrived the occupants were out safely.

Away From Home  
The destroyed attic apartment was occupied by Mr. and Mrs. Donald Schiewer and their son, Donnie, 2, who were away when the fire broke out.

The building is owned by Thomas L. Neal, 3344 Guilford Ave., who was out of town.

The Fire Department was not certain as to the cause of the fire. Faulty wiring was suspected.

Besides the burned out apartment, the lower floors were saturated with water poured onto the blaze through nine lines thrown out by firemen, who had to call aid after the first alarm.

The first floor contained three apartments occupied by nine persons, and the second floor contained three apartments and three sleeping rooms occupied by five persons at the time of the fire. None was injured getting out of the building.

# Truman Told Senate Lags In Legislation

## Lucas May Ask Special Session After July 31

WASHINGTON, Apr. 4 (UP)—The Senate today unanimously amended the foreign aid authorization bill to ban U. S. relief shipments to Communist-controlled areas of China.

WASHINGTON, Apr. 4 (UP)—Senate Leader Scott W. Lucas of Illinois said today he may ask President Truman to call a special session of Congress late this summer unless legislators speed up work on important legislation.

"There is no question that the Senate is behind in its legislative program," Mr. Lucas said. A speed-up is needed at once if the congressional "streamlining" act provision for summer adjournment by July 31 is to be met, he said.

If by that date there is important legislation still awaiting action, Mr. Lucas said he would ask:

ONE: A joint resolution recessing the Senate from late July until a return-to-work date later in the summer, or

TWO: Request President Truman to call a special session.

It was the first admission by an administration leader that action on the "must" program is lagging.

Mr. Lucas keyed his remarks to the current log jam over the \$5,850,000,000 Marshall Plan extension. In 10 days of debate, he said, the Senate has voted on only two amendments. He ordered a night session tomorrow night to speed up the work.

House Plans Recess  
Democratic congressional leaders told President Truman earlier today the House is fairly certain to begin an 11-day Eastern recess April 14.

Meanwhile, Sen. William F. Knowland (R. Cal.), said today that Chinese Communist statements of support for Russia in any war with the West make mandatory a ban on U. S. relief shipments to Communist-controlled areas in China.

As the Senate met to push the Marshall Plan renewal toward a final vote, Mr. Knowland said he was ready for a "full dress debate" on what he described U. S. policy shortcomings in China.

He proposed that \$54 million in "frozen" China aid funds be made available, but only with a directive to President Truman that the money be spent only in those areas still controlled by the nationalist government.

Farms  
The House Appropriations Committee proposed today that Congress give the Agriculture Department \$701,122,079 to spend next year, including something extra for school lunches.

Reporting the department's annual money bill to the House, the committee said that despite an extra direct appropriation of \$75 million for the lunch program it had trimmed the President's budget for the agency by \$25,798,829. But the department will be able to spend, under the bill, about \$6 million more than the President requested.

Other congressional developments:  
Labor Law  
A coalition of Republican and Southern Democrats opposing President Truman's Taft-Hartley repealer claimed to have the upper hand in both the Senate and House.

In the Senate, the group expects to add many provisions of the Taft-Hartley law to the administration's measure. But its leaders concede the chamber will vote the "Taft-Hartley" off the books.

In the House, however, the coalition openly claims enough strength to kill the administration bill altogether.

Pensions  
The House Veterans Committee was reported sharply divided over whether or not to include World War II veterans for benefit under the new Rankin pension bill.

As the bill now stands, it provides \$72 monthly pensions for needy, 65-year-old veterans of World War I only. Tomorrow the committee will consider an amendment offered by Rep. Olin E. Teague (D. Tex.), to include World War II veterans as well.
