

# Local Churches Plan Holy Week Program

## Good Friday Services to Pay Honor to Christ on Cross

The churches of Indianapolis and the Church Federation announce services from noon until 3 p. m. on Good Friday to commemorate the hours Christ hung on the Cross.

Individual congregations will hold services or combine with others for united worship during the three hours or a part of them in neighborhoods over the city.

Children and young people will attend a Good Friday service in the services beginning at noon Good Friday in the First Baptist Church. Dr. Macy, in the city, the invitation of the Church Federation, and Dr. Howard J. Baumgartel executive secretary, also will preach daily at noon today and tomorrow in the First Baptist Church.

The Church Federation will sponsor the three-hour observances in both the Lyric and the First Baptist Church. Different speakers, devotional leaders, musicians and singers will be featured in both the theater and the church. The Rev. Benton B. Miller, pastor of the Olive Branch Christian Church, is chairman of the committee for the services and Fred L. Lake and the Indianapolis Choir Association are in charge of the music.

Christ Episcopal Church on the Circle, the Goodwill Industries, the Methodist Hospital, the Roberts Park Methodist Church, the Unity Truth Center, the Federation of Evangelical Lutheran Churches in Keith's Theater all will hold three-hour services on Good Friday.

Dr. Paul G. Macy, executive secretary of the Evanson, Ill., Council of

Church of God, will give the devotions, and the Warren Central High School Choir will sing, directed by Kathleen Hergt.

Dr. Macy will address the second hour meeting, 1 to 2 p. m., in the Lyric. The Rev. L. K. Thompson, pastor of the Bellaire Methodist Church, will lead the devotions and the Fellowship Choir of the Indianapolis Council of Church Women, will sing.

Dr. Dallas L. Browning, pastor of the North Methodist Church, will preach during the three hours or a part of them in the shooting of Fassett W. Hinshaw, 51-year-old Shirley banker, was sought today in an extensive hunt by Indianapolis and State Police.

Following partial confessions obtained from two men in the shooting, Clarence Gorman, 27, of 2220 N. Talbot Ave., was hunted as the one who shot down Mr. Hinshaw but the banker answered a knock at his door at the south edge of the Henry County community.

The victim remained in a critical condition in Henry County Hospital, New Castle, today with a bullet wound in his abdomen. Mr. Hinshaw is president of the Citizens Bank of Shirley.

Two men captured here yesterday have confessed a part in the shooting but said Gorman was the actual gunman.

Francis Earl Hinckley, 19, also of 2220 N. Talbot Ave., and Lawrence Albert Anderson, 30, of 2420 N. Pennsylvania St., were arrested at their homes yesterday.

In their sketchy confessions they gave no motive for the shooting. State and city police believed the men planned to kidnap Mr. Hinshaw and make him open the bank vaults.

Police thought the gunman might have become nervous and shot Mr. Hinshaw.

Hinckley admitted to police he remembered "standing in the front yard of the banker's home while the other two men went up on the porch."

He said he heard a shot and ran out of the yard with the others. They got in their car parked nearby and drove back to Indianapolis.

A stolen black sedan with Nevada license plates, reported Anderson

was seen by Shirley residents several days ago cruising near the bank, was discovered in front of Anderson's home.

Anderson admitted stealing the car in Nevada Mar. 28.

Gorman who was convicted in California of violating the Dyer Act, had been employed for about three weeks by the Nickel Plate

detective, said the charges probably would be changed to armed robbery. In the event Mr. Hinshaw dies they and Gorman would be charged with first degree murder.

A .32 caliber revolver was found in a shoe box in Hinckley's room yesterday along with several revolver shells.
