

## GOP Needs Youth, Attorney Says

### Hinds Urges 'Sale' Of Party Principles

The Republican Party has failed to sell its principles to the young people of the country, declared Lawrence H. Hinds, attorney, at a luncheon meeting of the GOP Citizens Advisory Committee at the Columbia Club today.

"No one in America who adheres to the Republican Party principles and who is 42 years of age or under has ever had the opportunity to vote for a winning Republican President," he said.

"It would seem, therefore, that we should concern ourselves primarily with a selling job of making our party one of attraction for young people."

### Party Needs Youth

Mr. Hinds, answering the committee's question: "What's wrong with the Republican Party?" said: "Encourage young men and women to participate in Republican politics and give them a real and lasting voice in the party."

The attorney also advocated establishment of a top-grade public relations department to sell the people the party's program. Joe E. Beckett, Advisory Committee chairman, announced the appointment of Frederick Schortemeier as chairman of the group's executive committee to prepare material for GOP platform suggestions.

Holland will drive the "baby" Blue Crown in 100-mile National Champion races next Sunday on the mile Wisconsin State Fairgrounds at Milwaukee, and on June 19 at the New Jersey State Fairgrounds in Trenton.
