

## Await Chinese Reaction to Ship's Escape

### Exploit May Force American-British Showdown With Reds

HONG-KONG, Aug. 4—Escape of the British sloop Amethyst from the clutches of the Chinese Reds has jeopardized 400 Britons and perhaps to a lesser extent thousands of other foreigners in Communist China.

Also, it is possible that the exploit may signal or force a showdown in the policy of both Britain and America toward the Chinese Communists.

Presumably orders for the Amethyst's get-away originated from high-level sources in London and the nature of Communist reaction probably was weighed beforehand.

If it was not a sheer gamble with the future, London must have reckoned on the strong possibility of Red-engendered mob violence not only against Britons, especially in Shanghai, but against all foreigners everywhere in Red China.

Something along that line is the likeliest result of the Amethyst's defiant dash for freedom after three months during which Red guns held her hostage for payment of "indemnity" for the Apr. 20 Yangtze incident.

#### Mob Action Possible

The British government, you may be sure, is now awaiting official Chinese Communist reactions with fingers crossed. But unofficial reaction may be even more important.

To several hundred thousand people in Shanghai the Amethyst's escape will be whatever the Communists want to call it—a break of faith, frightened retreat or "imperialist" insult to the "people's government."

Shanghai hooligans need only a tolerant wink or whisper to start mob action. They could always be officially disowned.

It's difficult to imagine what action Britain might be prepared to take if the Communists publicly or secretly declared an open season on British subjects. Shanghai is not completely inaccessible to determined naval intervention. But Britons in Peking, Tientsin, Nanking and hundreds of smaller places in Red regions would be beyond immediate help.

#### Relations Strained

The Amethyst's escape caps a strain that had developed between the United States and Shanghai Communist authorities over mob interference last week with the U.S. consulate there.

In that case the Reds withheld police protection. That hands-off attitude now familiar to Americans in Shanghai could be a pattern for any reprisals taken against the U.S. community.

Up to now Britons in Shanghai had been comparatively undisturbed in their dream of business as usual with the Reds.
