

Two Killed, Six Injured As Fire Razes Home

FAIRFIELD, Conn., Sept. 2 (UPI) — Two persons were killed and six others, including an infant, were injured when an explosion and fire early today destroyed a two-family frame house.

Stephen Golias, 45, and his son, Charles, 14, were killed. Witnesses said that Mr. Golias got out of the burning house safely, but re-entered when he discovered his son missing. Their bodies were found together on the first floor.

Mr. Golias' other son, Stephen, 18, his brother, John, 12, and his father, Frank, 70, were hospitalized with burns. His sister, Mrs. Miltilda Nemec, 28, her husband, Michael, 29, and their infant son, Thomas, were also injured.
