Why Was Sin Permitted?

Did God create such beings as the Devil and his angels? No! God is in nowise responsible for sin. Moses said: "I will publish the name of the Lord; ascribe ye greatness unto our God. He is the Rock, HIS WORK IS PERFECT: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity; just and right is He. THEY HAVE CORRUPTED THEMSELVES, their spot is not the spot of His children." (Deut. 32:3-5)

Why Was Sin Permitted? (continued)
God has never made anything that was corrupt, or evil. Those who are corrupt, whether men or angels, have corrupted themselves. Satan and his host were originally holy angels in Heaven, but they sinned and became what they are today. We read: "God spared not the angels THAT SINNED" (2 Peter 2:4). "The angels which KEPT NOT THEIR FIRST ESTATE, but left their own habitation;" etc. (Jude 6). They were cast out of their original habitation into this earth. (Rev. 12:9-10)

Why Was Sin Permitted? (continued)
The Lord knew this method would not work, therefore he did not assume the role of a dictator. In His infinite wisdom, He has chosen a better way. Instead of using force, He says: "I have loved thee with an everlasting love: THEREFORE WITH LOVING KINDNESS HAVE I DRAWN THEE." (Jer. 31:3). The supreme manifestation of that love is seen in the gift of His dear Son on Calvary. (John 3:16)

Why Was Sin Permitted? (continued)
After the inhabitants of the universe have carefully observed the remarkable manifestations of God's loving kindness, and great patience toward us for about six thousand years, and have witnessed the terrible results of disobedience to His holy law, they will have no doubt about his way being the only right way. Then Satan and his host will be forever destroyed, and no one will feel that God has been unjust in his dealings with them.

Why Was Sin Permitted? (continued)
GOD COULD HAVE MADE MEN AND ANGELS SO THAT THEY COULD NOT SIN, OR DISOBEY HIM. But they would have been like a mechanical doll which always says: "I love you," simply because it cannot do otherwise. Such an expression merely amuses us, but if it comes from the lips of our children our souls thrill with delight, because we know there is thought and feeling and choice back of it. And so it is with our Heavenly Father. He finds much pleasure and satisfaction in His children when they love and serve Him simply because they appreciate His goodness and mercy, and therefore CHOOSE to do His will. But He would find no satisfaction in a forced mechanical obedience.

Why Was Sin Permitted? (continued)
The future kingdom will be composed of men and angels who have, of their own free will, CHOSEN Christ as their everlasting King JUST BECAUSE THEY LOVE HIM. This will insure the universe against the recurrence of any trouble in the ages to come. WE HAVE THE BLESSED ASSURANCE THAT "AFFLICTION SHALL NOT RISE UP THE SECOND TIME." (Read Nahum 1:5-10.) Friend, do you sincerely love the Lord? Can you truthfully say: "I DELIGHT to do Thy will, O my God; yea, Thy law is within my heart."
