The pity went to their wives, who had all the privations of the frontier farm-women with the distressing added obligations of having to look piously cheerful when the Indians had just shot the new calf, or taught the children a new curse.
He had a lively sense now, one that he had longed for at Elliot House, of belonging to the whole family of missionaries. They called him "Brother" and "Aaron" and "Neighbor"; they patted his arm, and urged, "Lad, you come break bread with us whenever you can. We won't have much to offer you, but we can always put another potato in the pot and spread out another buffalo robe on the floor, and show our dear love for you as one of the communion of saints!"
Aaron had found his family. And he was convinced that they would take in Selene and that she would take them in; blissfully convinced of it, even though he did not believe it.
