Kohleth Club Sets Meeting Tonight

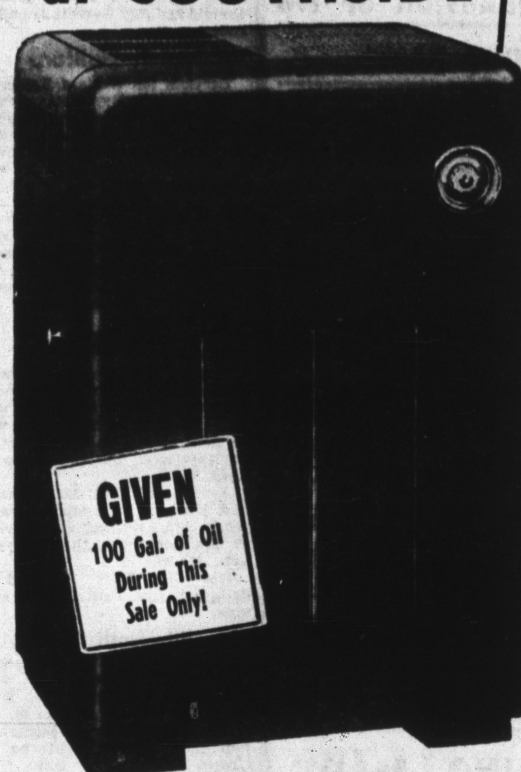
