

Local Seamen Among 40,000 Sailing On Fall Maneuvers In Pacific

Roland T. Pond, seaman, USN, of 6415 E. 11th St., is serving aboard an attack transport, the USS Randall, which is participating in "Operation Miki," an amphibious exercise in the Pacific. The maneuvers, scheduled for late September, October and November, involve nearly 40,000 sailors, soldiers and marines and are designed to dislodge an imaginary aggressor from the Hawaiian Islands.

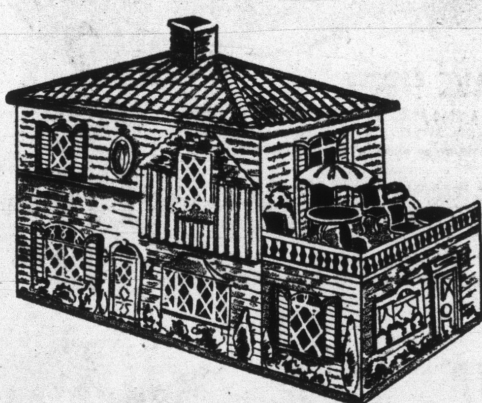

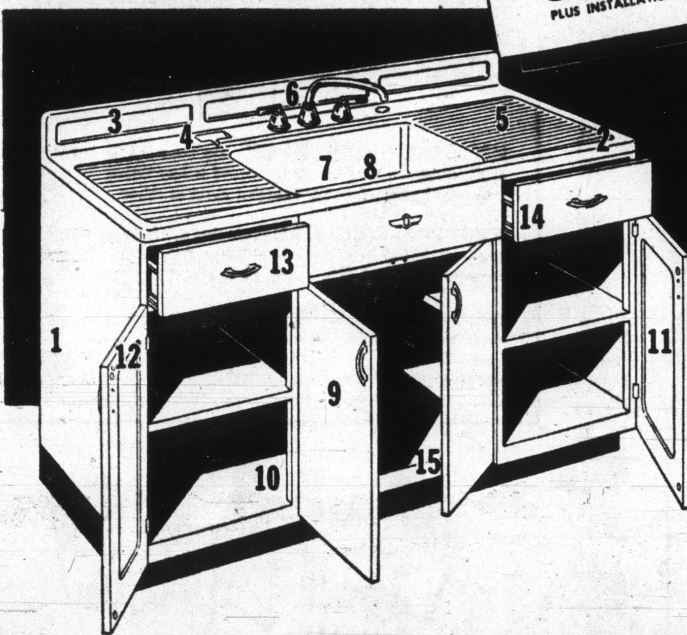
