

Three More Die In State Traffic

Walkerton Man Killed In Head-On Crash

Three more Hoosiers are dead today as traffic accidents continued to take heavy toll on state highways and city streets.

A Walkerton man was killed instantly and another critically injured in a car-truck collision on Ind. 23, a mile north of Walkerton, early this morning.

Police said Hugh Elliot, 26, was killed when the car he was driving collided head-on with a truck operated by Lewis Everly, 44, also of Walkerton. Mr. Everly was critically injured when his truck cab burst into flames after the impact.

Others in the Elliot car, Mrs. Mary Ake, of North Liberty, and Mrs. Cleota Elliot, were less seriously injured.

Two Men Killed

Two Marion men were killed yesterday when they drove their truck into a Pennsylvania Railroad train on Ind. 15, 12 miles north of Wabash.

They were Frederick D. Ratcliff, 36, and Raymond C. Burch, 28, both of Marion.

At South Bend Edward Stokes, 76-year-old pedestrian, was killed when struck by a motorcycle while crossing U. S. 31 in the outskirts of the city.

'Wings Over Jordan' Concerts Booked Here

'Wings Over Jordan,' well known Negro choir, will present two concerts at churches here in Indianapolis. The choir will be in Our Savior Lutheran Church, 26th and Capitol, at 8 p. m. tomorrow and in the Trinity Lutheran Church, Ohio and East Street at 8:15 p. m. Sunday, according to an announcement by the Rev. Walter C. Maas, pastor of the Trinity Church.

The choir, currently on a cross-country tour, averages 50,000 miles each year during its concert travels. 'Wings Over Jordan,' the only choral group to be sent to the battle-front during World War II, spent ten months overseas.

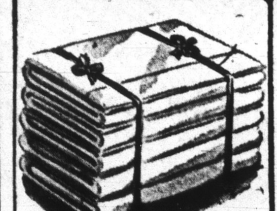
