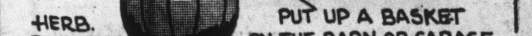

SWEET- ON THE BARN OR GARAGE

BASKET BALL WITH BUSHEL BASKETS—Some week-ends when you lack something to do that is full of action, put up a bushel and play basketball. Now, you don't have to have a regulation metal ring goal and fancy backboard to have a good time. In fact a regulation goal 10 feet high is too much of a strain for your players.

To make your backyard goal use a saw, and cut the bottom of a strong bushel basket. Nail the top edge of the basket to the side of a barn or garage away from any windows. Nail it so the top of the rim is about twice as high from the ground as the average player's head. With screw eyes and wire, brace the bushel by fastening a wire from each of the handles to the screw eyes placed on each side and above the basket. When it is level, it is ready for use.

If a regulation sized basketball is not available, any large ball that bounces will give you a lot of fun. "Make baskets" and have your own "TOWNSHIP OF BARN BASKETBALL."
