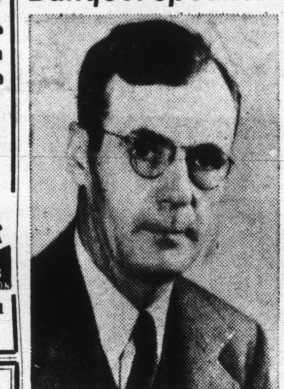

### Army Raises Recruit Basis

U. S. Army enlistment standards have been raised to new requirements in both mental and physical status. Maj. Norman H. Shortridge, recruiting sector commander, announced today.

Applicants for Army life now must score 90 on the mental test, compared to a previous requirement of 80, Maj. Shortridge said. Only those in perfect physical condition will be accepted.

Exceptions will be made for those re-enlisting within 90 days of discharge or those who have graduated from high school within the last two years.

Maj. Shortridge also announced that all one-year enlistments in the Army and Air Force have been suspended. The Army now has enlistments open for three, four, five and six years. The Air Force has omitted the three-year enlistment.

**Woman Gets 3 Years For Lonely Hearts Fraud**  
SIOUX CITY, Iowa, Oct. 12 (UP)—Nettie Rose Cutting, 48, sentenced to three years in prison for a "lonely hearts" scheme which netted her about \$2000 a year, said she used the money to support her mother.

Federal District Judge Henry Craven heard her guilty plea and refused probation because she said the crime was "too serious." Tobias Diamond, federal district attorney, said Miss Cutting admitted being married five times.
