I've done everything I can think of to get my husband to live like a man with three children should. Everybody tries to tell him he should do better, but he won't.

I'm scared to death of him. He drinks from beaten up on me since our first child was born. I have a big scar from him hitting me. He also has hit my relatives. When he's sober he doesn't remember what he did.

He doesn't care what he says or how he looks when he drinks, and I hate to have the children see him drunk and vulgar. He wants I want to keep the children together, so he thinks I will put up with anything. I hate to board them out, and besides I haven't the money.

He's been in jail several times and won't pay back the money I borrowed to get him out. We're far behind on our bills, but he spends between \$5 and \$15 a week. I've begged him to bring his liquor home if he has to drink, but he isn't satisfied here. He goes to the roughest places in town and runs with guys who have been in jail. I was 17 and he was 25 when we married. I didn't know then that he drank all the time, or that he had been married before. That really hurt me.

A Reader.

I know that you're trying to get along, and that you're bound to lose patience. He may never be worth living with, but you'll be better satisfied if you give him every chance to change. Talk over your difficulties with the Family Service Association. You may be making some mistakes that you fail to see.

I wouldn't hound him about the first wife. He should have told you that he had been married, but his first marriage isn't as serious as the mess he is making of his second. Nursing your bruised feelings won't gain you his respect and companionship. Thinking that you and the neighbors are against him won't make him try to earn self-respect.

I THINK I love a boy even though I see him wink at other girls. He has black hair and blue eyes. We're both 15.

I think he can be a nice boy though my folks don't approve of him because of what people say about him. (What they say isn't nice at all.) I believe in him and trust him, but don't see him any more since he's in a different
