Escapee Eludes Would-Be Captor

Police Comb City For Fugitive

An escaped convict who got away from prison guards last Thursday when they permitted him to go to the rest room undetected was sought here today, after he grappled free from a man who tried to turn him over to police last night.

The fugitive, Fred A. (Pete) Pacella, former Indianapolis cab driver, broke free from Glen Figley, 22, of 1110 Kentucky Ave., at McCarty and West Sts. at 10 p. m.

Mr. Figley told police Pacella had called last night at the home of a woman described as his "girl friend." She attempted to persuade him to give himself up, police said, but he refused.

Pacella left and the girl sent Mr. Figley to McCarty and West Sts. where Pacella's car was parked. It was there that Mr. Figley first tried to persuade Pacella to give himself up, then started wrestling with him.

They grappled and Pacella broke away, Mr. Figley said. Pacella, who was serving a 10- to 20-year sentence for the daylight holdup of the Railway Express Agency in Greenfield, was being returned to Michigan City State Prison last Thursday after a hearing on his request for a new trial in Hancock Circuit Court.

Escapes Through Window

His guards, a Michigan City guard and a trusty, removed his handcuffs while Pacella ate. They allowed him to go to the rest room unguarded and unhandcuffed. He locked the door behind him, slipped out a window and
