Seaman, AWOL 3 Years at Base, Can Collect Pay

WASHINGTON, Nov. 2 (UP)—Navy officials said today that Seaman Louis B. Williams, of Hutchins, Tex., who was AWOL for more than three years without leaving his base, may collect his back pay and go unpunished.

A court-martial convicted Seaman Williams for "unauthorized absence" from the naval service for 123 days while he was stationed at Pearl Harbor.

BUT Secretary of Navy Francis P. Matthews' best legal talent later determined that Seaman Williams was not AWOL, since he spent the entire period on the base. There he showed up for chow, slept in his assigned bunk, and played baseball on a service team.

Records showed that Seaman Williams was assigned to an escape tank unit at the Pearl Harbor submarine base on July 13, 1945. He never was notified officially about his post, and never showed up for work. Mr. Matthews set aside the court-martial's findings and ordered Williams returned to duty.

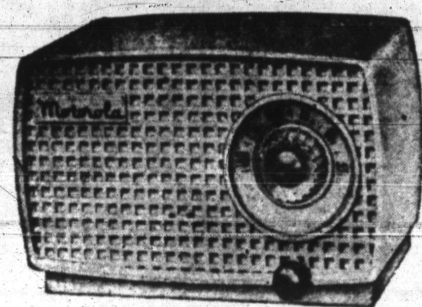
Four-year-old Patricia Aarons scratches and bruises. She landed the dog.

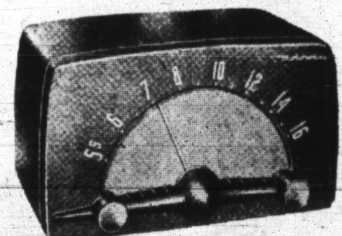
