

## 4 Ways to Save Ft. Ben Studied

### C of C to Invite GHQ Of 5th Army to Move

Four possibilities of saving Ft. Benjamin Harrison as a military reservation will be investigated by the National Defense Committee of the Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce.

Ft. Harrison is slated to be closed when the 10th Air Force moves to new headquarters in Michigan. The move is part of the economy program of Secretary of Defense Louis Johnson.

The C of C committee is to meet soon in Chicago with commanding officers of the 5th Army to discuss the feasibility of

moving their headquarters to Ft. Harrison. The committee will also investigate possibilities of converting the local Army post for combat or special training schools, headquarters for training of reserve troops or declaring Ft. Harrison surplus and transferring title to the State for use as headquarters for the state police or National Guard.

The chamber board of directors approved the committee's plans to save Ft. Harrison at a meeting last night.

### GI Farm Trainee Killed

SEYMOUR, Nov. 11 (UP)—Harlan Darlage, 29, a member of a GI farm training class, was killed yesterday when he apparently fell from a tractor and was run over by a disc. The tractor, which had stopped a short distance from the man's body, was noticed by a passerby who investigated.

## Truck Rolls Over 4 Times; 8 Die

### 15 Others Hurt In Desert Crash

GILA BEND, Ariz., Nov. 11 (UP)—Eight men were killed when a truck loaded with 23 cotton pickers swerved into another truck, turned over four times and scattered its passengers over the desert, police said today.

Authorities at Phoenix and Ajo hospitals said the other 15 victims were in critical or serious condition.

### Give First Aid

Heroes of the disaster last night were registered nurse Loraine Warren, 21, San Diego, Cal., and Navy Pharmacist's Mate Garreth Nelson, 21, Safford, Ariz. Passengers on a bus that arrived immediately on the scene 17 miles west of here, they took charge of first aid.

Until ambulances sped to the scene, Miss Warren and Mr. Nelson cared for the wounded, many screaming with agony and nearly all drenched with blood.

Six men were killed outright, one died en route to the hospital and the eighth succumbed on the emergency operating table at Maricopa County Hospital.

Casual Laborers  
Although rescuers worked frantically in the inky darkness to locate and care for the victims, mostly casual laborers, no definite identification was possible immediately.

Charles Davis, Los Angeles, driver of the truck, said he attempted to pass the slow moving trailer, loaded with 30 tons of airplane engines, but swerved on the rain-soaked highway and smashed into the trailer's side.

The truck turned over four times, hurling dead and injured for more than 200 yards along the highway.

## 4 Ask Dismissal Of Indictments

### Pleas Made in Bank Embezzlement Case

HAMMOND, Nov. 11 (UP)—Four of six men charged with aiding in the embezzlement of \$350,000 from the Spencerville, Ind., Farmers and Merchants Bank, have asked dismissal of indictments against them.

The four, whose attorneys submitted a motion to dismiss the indictments to federal court here yesterday, are Leroy J. Chaney, 26, a used car dealer; Dale C. Wicoff, Spencerville school teacher; Ray Hoover, a grocer, and

Andrew J. Miller, Leo, Ind., hatchery owner. Chaney's attorney, Clarence McNabb, contended that the indictments were redundant and that they were too wordy to permit a clear understanding of the charges.

Lesall Bardsley, a Harlan, Ind., trucker, entered a plea of innocent to a five-count indictment.

Clyde G. Rectenwall, 65, the bank's cashier, entered a plea of innocent Oct. 29 at Ft. Wayne.
