C of C to Invite GHQ Of 5th Army to Move

Four possibilities of saving Ft. Benjamin Harrison as a military reservation will be investigated by the National Defense Committee of the Indiana Chamber of Commerce.

Ft. Harrison is slated to be closed when the 10th Air Force moves to new headquarters in Michigan. The move is part of the economy program of Secretary of Defense Louis Johnson.

The C of C committee is to meet soon in Chicago with commanding officers of the 5th Army to discuss the feasibility of

moving their headquarters to Ft. Harrison.

The committee will also investigate possibilities of converting the local Army post for combat or special training schools, headquarters for training of reserve troops, or decommissioning Ft. Harrison surplus and transferring title to the State for use as headquarters for the state police or National Guard.

4 Ask Dismissal Of Indictments

Pleas Made in Bank Embezzlement Case

HAMMOND, Nov. 11 (UPI)—Four of six men charged with aiding in the embezzlement of \$350,000 from the Spencerville, Ind., Farmers and Merchants Bank, have asked dismissal of indictments against them.

The four, whose attorneys submitted a motion to dismiss the indictments to federal court here yesterday, are Leroy J. Chaney, 26, a used car dealer; Dale C. Wicoff, Spencerville school teacher; Ray Hoover, a grocer, and


