Bette Davis Opposed Playing In 'Beyond the Forest'

She says she never wanted to make the picture, predicting that the book, because of censorship, could never be transferred honestly to the screen and that its entertainment value would suffer.

Mary Jane C. McKay, 353 N. Bolton Ave.—"Singing school was the social occasion. Held at night, the young and old walked to the school house. Here they opened their mouths and sang long. The itinerant singing master with tuning-fork on a cord about his neck, which dangled and jerked as he swayed and gestured, was 'ogled' by big girls and designing mothers. Meeting dismissed, the swains sidled up to their best girls, pairing off to walk them home. Family groups moved off together, fathers carrying sleepy young ones 'piggy-back'."

Another suggestion: Mrs. Katherine Grater, R.R. 11, Box-314—"Back in 1913 when we went housekeeping, I made out a list of groceries for about everything we would need to start in with... including a 24-pound sack of flour and 10 pound sack of sugar. My husband had to borrow the grocer's wheel barrow to bring them home. It was really full and came to only \$4."

Martha Romber, 224 E. North St.—"One of my fondest memories is of the serenaders. They were groups of young men playing banjos, mandolins and guitars as they walked. It was delightful to hear them approaching late at night and, especially so, when stops were made to serenade girl friends that had the luck to live on the boys' route home. Often the boys were invited for a late snack which was enjoyed by all the youngsters but sometimes frowned upon by some strict parents."

Recalls Long Underwear: George J. Schafer, 561 W. Morris St.—"I think my Aunt Clara could claim the title of the first backseat driver. My uncle and

and their six children were on their way to visit some friends in another town in their 1912 Buick touring car, with the top down. As my uncle was making a turn onto another road, my aunt screamed, 'Not that way, Joe.' He swerved the car back, it turned over on its side and spilled the whole family into a clover field."
