The oval formed outlines the "turtle shell" so that the head, four legs and tail may be sketched in their proper position. With scissors cut out the turtle outline and glue the shell on the oval, bending the legs down so the turtle stands up.

Paint a band of splashes around the shell and color the cardboard a brown or green to make the "turtle" more life-like. Dot in the eyes, and see if you can fool people with your pet. Turtles may be slow but you can make these in a hurry.
