Rockne was killed when the plane on which he was traveling crashed in a Kansas wheat field Mar. 31, 1931.

The annual commemorative breakfast, sponsored by the Notre Dame Club of St. Joseph Valley, will be held in the faculty dining hall.

Jimmy Crowley, one of Rockne's famous "Four Horsemen" backfield of 1924, will be the principal speaker.
