

New Southport School Likely



Board Studies Plea For \$240,000 Bonds

Construction of a \$440,000 junior high school in Southport loomed today as the State Tax Board took under advisement a petition to approve school building bonds to the amount of \$240,000.

Seventy-five Perry Township taxpayers appeared before the board yesterday in support of the issue. Noble W. Holler, chairman of the board, said decision on the bond issue would be made within a few days.

Contribute \$200,000

The township accumulated school building fund would contribute \$200,000 to the building of the school.

Nelson P. Swift, Perry Township trustee, told the board the proposed building would accommodate 1200 seventh, eighth- and ninth-graders and would include 24 classrooms, a cafeteria and boiler rooms.

A 30-acre site for the new school already has been selected and approved by the State Board of School Building Construction. Mr. Swift said.




