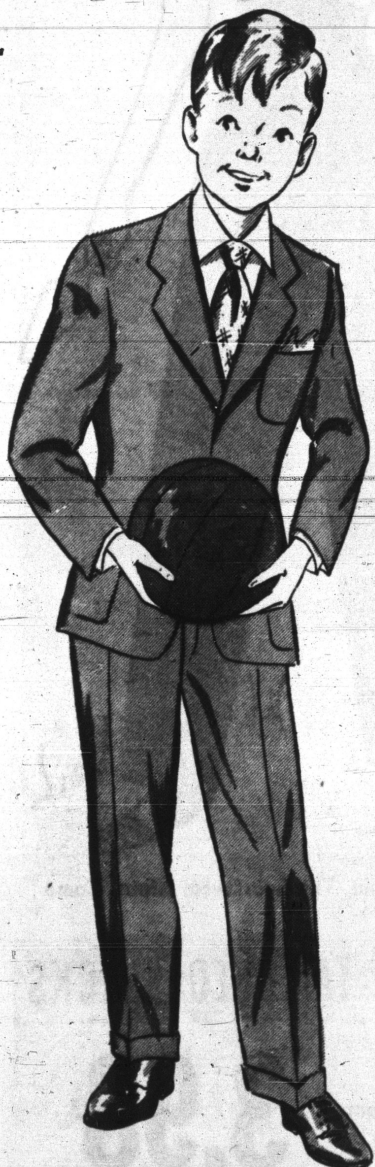

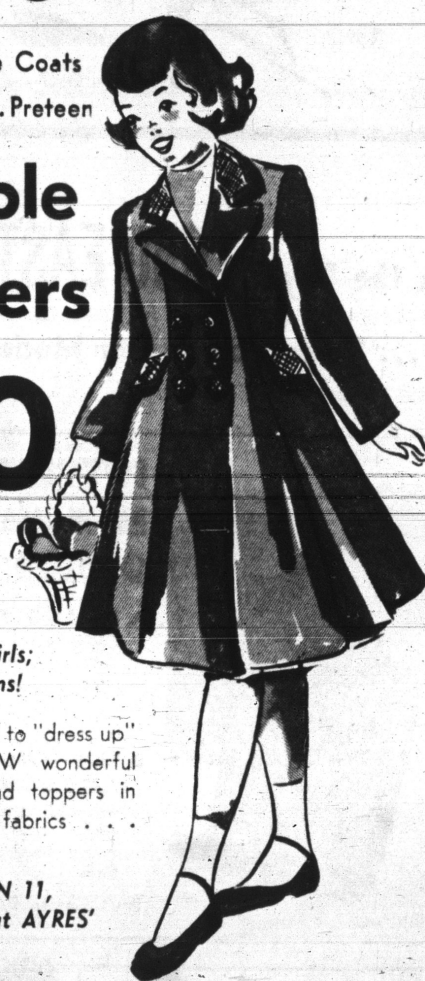

New Real Silk Wage Scales Set

Contract Provides
4% Pension Plan

New adjusted wage scales go into effect at the Real Silk Mills Monday.

In some instances it will cut take-home pay for piece work, but it carries a 4 per cent company-paid pension plan.

The new contract is an industry-wide agreement covering all full-fashion hosiery makers, a spokesman for Real Silk said.

He explained that new machinery and the increase in the use of nylon thread had shot piece work pay up to a point where it was getting "abnormally high" for the industry.

The new machines make longer sections, increasing production per worker, and nylon thread is stronger, doesn't break as often as rayon.

There was some dissatisfaction among piece-work employees. One woman phoned The Times and complained that her husband has "lost \$30 a week," which the company said might be possible in the adjustment but surely would be rare.

The full-fashion agreement was made with the Independent American Federation of Hosiery workers.

New Budd Rail Car To Get Monon Test

The new Budd Rail Car, powered by two Detroit diesel engines and equipped with a new hydraulic transmission made by Allison Division of General Motors Corp., will go into test operation on the Monon Railroad tomorrow.

The new car, of light-weight stainless steel, will make two trips daily on the Monon. The first trip will start at Bloomington and return to Bedford and the second trip will start at Bedford and return to Bloomington.

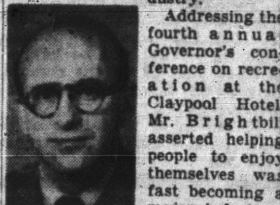
