Harris Ruled in Contempt; High Court Orders Arrest

Investigate the regular prosecuting attorney in Harris' court.
Harris called a special grand jury and asked it to appoint a prosecutor to investigate. Prosecutor John Knox Purcell, Mr. Purcell had filed charges of forgery, embezzlement and writing a bad check against Harris after a special judge voided grand jury indictments stating the same charges.

"It is true that when our Mar. 27 order was finally written, the respondent judge (Harris) was careful to instruct the grand jury it alone was to be the sole judge of what it investigated," the Supreme Court ruling said. "This court, however, is not blind and we think it clear from all the actions and conduct of (Harris) that he was making a strenuous effort to influence the grand jury to investigate (Purcell)."

It was the first time in 25 years the Supreme Court had cited anyone for contempt. The last case was in 1925 and the respondent was sent to jail for six months.

Worked With Robeson
Harris was co-chairman last summer with Singer Paul Robeson of a committee protesting the trial of 11 top Communists in New York City.

Harris and Mr. Purcell have been at odds since early this year when Harris' second year of his six-year term as judge began.

Meanwhile, a policeman's vacation has given Judge Harris another month of grace before he

must face the music on a drunk charge here.
The embattled jurist appeared before Judge Joseph M. Howard today, keeping the date he broke last Thursday when he went to St. Louis for a reunion of his World War I outfit, the 35th Division.

The rearrest warrant issued by Judge Howard last week was recalled. Judge Howard continued the case until July 14, so the arresting officer, Robert Alkire, can testify.

Harris was released without bond.
In reference to the publicity he received by going to the 35th Division reunion, Harris told Judge Howard:

"Don't pay any attention to what was in the papers. It was grossly exaggerated." Harris was quoted as saying he would return for trial "When I get damned good and ready."

Harris was arrested in front of the statehouse May 24 and was released without bond for appearance last Thursday.

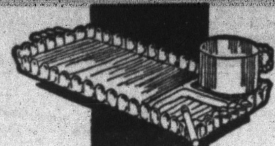
