MANY OF YOU wives will be bidding your men goodby. Show them the good stuff you're made of. You may not have another chance.

It wasn't until the telegram arrived from the War Department in the last war that I realized I'd done a bad job as a wife. I didn't get another chance.

I failed my husband. I worried more about myself and the inconveniences of war than I did about the man who fought for me. I wrote him gloomy letters. I made his life a nightmare with my complaints and aches and pains when he came home on leaves. All I talked about were

shortages, arguments with the neighbors, and my loneliness.

He didn't say a word about the shortages and loneliness in the trenches.

Something made him the good soldier he was. It wasn't me.

Had I ever lost faith in humanity? I'd regain it, in war time. I'd regain it in women as well as men, for many women did tremendous jobs of working and waiting in the last war.

When it comes to something serious, men are there, without flourish, and they do us proud, don't they?

A Marine, who spent four years in prison camps and lost nearly half his weight, was amazed at my civilian attitude of feeling he had done his part. He is ready again.

The young son of old friends of mine, well on his way to big-time orchestras, called, certain he's en route to Korea. "I'll do all right," he said cheerfully. He is ready.

A Reserve officer told me, lightly, he'd do anything to stay out of the war. I happen to know he wants duty in fighting zones and he is doing everything possible to correct a slight physical defect to make himself ready.
