Capehart, Halleck Launch Campaign

County Republicans Hold Picnic-Parley

Sen. Homer E. Capehart and Rep. Charles Halleck yesterday touched off the Marion County Republican campaign at a rally in Longacre Park.

The picnic-parley attracted approximately 900 county GOP workers.

Sen. Capehart blamed the Democratic Party for the Korean War, the nation's unpreparedness and fiscal insecurity.

He said the nation today is in its darkest period because of administration fumbling.

"Three wars in 33 years, a national debt of \$260 billion and the fact we have boys losing their lives in Korea and not even knowing what they are fighting for—that is the proof," he said.

"Jeffersonian Democrats"

If need be, he added, the GOP ranks with the "Jeffersonian Democrats" to push the Fair Deal out.

Both Sen. Capehart and Rep. Halleck blasted the administration's foreign policy.

The latter branded it one of "appeasement, inconsistency and hopelessness."

Rep. Halleck, calling attention to domestic issues, reminded his audience that the Truman administration still is pushing socialized medicine and Brannan farm programs.

Others at the session included Charles B. Brownson, 11th District congressional nominee; Dan Smith, sheriff nominee; Frank Fairchild, county prosecutor nominee, and Thomas Hasbrook, a blinded former Marine and GOP state representative nominee.

Fired Lieutenant Held 'Quibbling'

A National Guard lieutenant fired from the State Highway Department was "just quibbling" when he refused to sign a loyalty oath, Highway Commission Chairman Samuel Hadden said last night.

"Not so," said William G. Prescott, 30, of 6261 E. 24th St., who was fired after refusing to sign the oath required of state employees. He said he considered the oath he had signed with the Army and National Guard were "sufficient proof of my loyalty."

"The other employees objected to keeping him—they'd all signed," Mr. Hadden said.

Like Guard Oath

The state employees' oath is the same as the National Guard oath, except that it includes a reference to "organizations attempting by force to overthrow the government," which the National Guard oath does not, Mr. Hadden said.

Mr. Prescott said he was investigated by the FBI before being admitted to a counter intelligence school during World War II.

However, he added, "the state oath was put to me either to sign or be fired," despite a clause stating that the oath was "freely" given.

His signature "would not have been voluntary—it would have been to keep my job," he added.

Iron Curtain Closes Over 4th Member of Field Family

Wife of Former U. S. Aide in Reich Vanishes While Hunting Foster Father

BERLIN, Sept. 9 (UP)—A fourth member of the Field family, a beautiful brunet who was legally adopted by Noel Field in Switzerland during the war, has disappeared behind the Iron Curtain.

Allied intelligence sources said today.

Shapely, 25-year-old Mrs. Robert Wallach of Paris arrived in Berlin on Aug. 26 by plane from Frankfurt.

After clearing customs and passport inspection, investigators from Prague last year of Noel Field, his wife, Herta, and later Noel's brother, Hermann, were seen at a Warsaw airport.

"Just like Noel, Herta and Hermann Field, she vanished in thin air," said one weary investigator.

German Native

Mrs. Wallach is the German wife of an American formerly employed by the U. S. Military Government in the German state of Hess. She carried a stateless passport.

Mrs. Wallach hinted to friends that she hoped to learn something about the fate of Noel Field, her foster father.

Her strange disappearance has begun a new phase in the enigma surrounding the disappearance

Sometimes called the "champagne girl" because she once worked in a champagne works, Mrs. Wallach was described as well-mannered, well-educated and an intellectual. She has blue eyes and flowing hair.

Responsible authorities said Mrs. Wallach's disappearance may be linked directly with the current purge of East German Communist officials.

Friends said she had planned to get in touch with some of the 10 prominent Communists recently ousted from government and party posts here. They were charged with having conspired with Noel Field, alleged by the Communists to have been an American spy.

Despite being the wife of an American, U. S. authorities here said Mrs. Wallach was barred from entering the U. S. because of her known Communist background. She was leader of the Communist youth movement in Frankfurt University before she married Mr. Wallach.

Mr. Wallach himself was removed from his military government job when he married her after he had been shown the dossier on her, officials said.
