Purdue to Have Farm
'Outlook' Conference

**We'll Never Know How Many Died—
305,000 Germans Killed
By Allied Bombers in War**

780,000 Wounded, 7.5 Million Homeless,
But Full Toll Is Probably Far More

FRANKFURT, Germany, Oct. 5.—Purdue University will open its series of "Agricultural Outlook" meetings at 7:30 p.m. Monday in Winchester, Monticello and the Ft. Wayne Purdue University Center.

The meetings will be held in 73 towns and cities and will end Oct. 25.

Speakers will include N. S. Hadley, M. P. Mitchell, J. C. Bottom, F. H. Demaree, J. B. Kohlmeier, A. M. Niclter, L. R. Kyle, P. R. Robbins, C. R. Gross, J. O. Dunbar and Joseph Yeager of the Purdue University staff.

So it is, too, in Bremen, Essen, Hanover and Frankfurt or any other major city in the west of Germany.

There is always a figure of shocking proportions and a deep conviction on the part of the population that "poor Germany has suffered."

This conviction is responsible for a highly vocal and temporarily genuine resolution that Germany will never go to war again, "at least not on the losing side."

As you go from one German city to another, wandering past hundreds of acres of blackened rubble and gutted buildings, stepping aside for war cripples and blind men, the inevitable reaction is that Germany is right—that a country which has suffered so deeply cannot possibly be exposed to similar suffering again.

This may be true but the figures, as distributed so freely by German advertisers of the national woe, are phony. Compared to Russia, for instance, Germany got off with a bare tap on the wrist, as far as the loss of life was concerned.

For some reason known best to American officials it is still practically impossible to get official, authentic figures on the loss of life suffered by various German

Dr. Humphrey said it is too early to evaluate this phase of the studies.
