


'Veep' Barkley Speaks At Giant Democratic Party Rally Here

2000 Yelling, Singing Party Faithful Line Downtown Streets for Barkley Hoopla

As waving flares reddened the sky, more than 2000 Democrats yelled and sang their way through downtown Indianapolis streets last night in one of the biggest hoopla political demonstrations seen around here in years.

While the bands played "My Old Kentucky Home," Vice President Alben W. Barkley wheeled into the parade in an open convertible with Gov. Schricker and Alex Campbell, the Democratic candidate for the U. S. Senate.

Bands blared and drum corps rattled as the hour-long procession milled through Market St. around the Circle and out Massachusetts Ave. to the Murat Theater where hundreds jammed the auditorium.

Hundreds of marchers waved banners bearing huge pictures and slogans for Democratic candidates.



(Continued From Page One) provided the leadership in giving the American people the most advancement ever achieved in any other period in the history of the nation," he said.

"I heard a Republican leader showing that in 1932 we had 16 million unemployed selling apples and pencils on the streets . . . shape we are in. Thank God there is one Republican who can see the truth."




