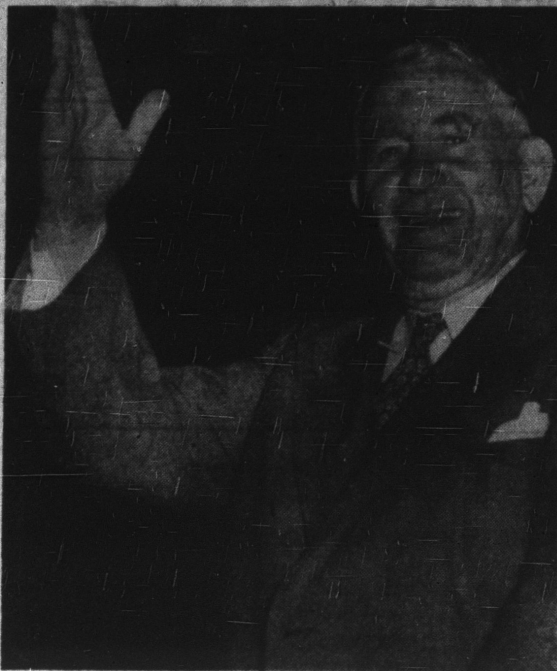


'Veep' Barkley Speaks At Giant Democratic Party Rally Here

2000 Yelling, Singing Party Faithful Line Downtown Streets for Barkley Hoopla

As waving flares reddened the sky, more than 2000 Democrats yelled and sang their way through downtown Indianapolis streets last night in one of the biggest hoopla political demonstrations seen around here in years.

While the bands played "My Old Kentucky Home," Vice President Alben W. Barkley wheeled the parade in an open convertible with Gov. Schriener and Alex Campbell, the Democratic candidate for the U. S. Senate.

Bands blared and drum corps rattled as the hour-long procession milled through Market St., around the Circle and out Massachusetts Ave. to the Muret Theater where hundreds jammed the auditorium.

Hundreds of marchers waved banners bearing huge pictures and slogans for Democratic candidates.

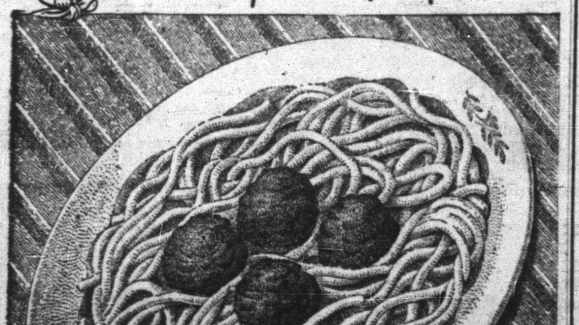

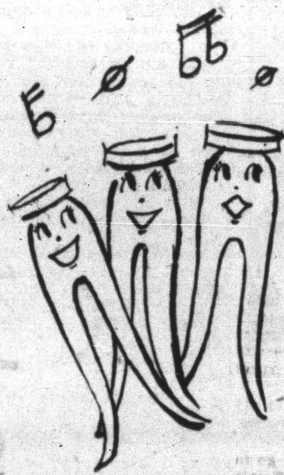
Barkley Blasts GOP Politics

(Continued From Page One) provided the leadership in giving the American people the most advancement ever achieved in any other period in the history of the nation," he said.

"I heard a Republican leader the other day blaming the Democratic administrations for the shape we are in. Thank God there is one Republican who can see the truth. "Yes, just look at the shape we are in now compared to the end of the last Republican administration in 1932 when we didn't have any shape." The Vice President said the difference can be seen in statistics "showing that in 1932 we had 16 million unemployed selling apples and pencils on the streets. . . . Now there is no unemployment." But every advancement the Democratic Party has provided the American people, he said, the Republican opposition denounces as "socialistic."

"The Republican Party is out to tear us down and pull us backward," he said. The Vice President launched into a long tirade against Republican "cheap smear tactics" in connection with Communism. "The Truman administration has taken the lead against communism in this country by finding out the facts and not with dirty smear methods," he said. "There were more Communists in this country in 1932 at the end of the Hoover administration than any other time before or since."

because communism breeds on with Gen. MacArthur and when disaster." Referring to the Korean War, the Vice President accused the Republican leadership of trying to "play politics with it." "They accused President Truman of blundering us into the conflict but I don't hear any of them saying anything about blundering us through to a quick and brilliant victory," he said. "The Republicans denounced the President for not conferring with Gen. MacArthur and when the President did go out and confer with the general the opposition called the trip 'dirty politics.' "That's the kind of campaign we're in and I urge the American people to go to the polls in full force as they never did before to protect our gains and strengthen our fight against communism and the threat of dictatorship trying to destroy our freedom."



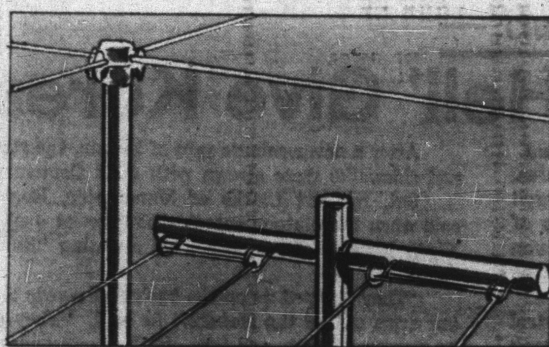
