

## Catholic Women To Convene Here

NCCW Parley  
Set Apr. 8-9

Catholic women of 119 parishes and 32 missions will assemble here for the 12th annual convention of the Indianapolis Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women April 8 and 9.

A Pontifical Low Mass April 8 at 9:30 a. m. in St. John's Church will open the convention proper. Highlights of the day will include departmental discussions, a luncheon and addresses in the Claypool Hotel. The board of directors will meet on Sunday, April 9, at 4 p. m. to elect officers and for a dinner meeting in the hotel.

The Most Rev. Paul C. Schulte, archbishop of Indianapolis, will be the celebrant for the mass and the Rev. Thomas Fields, St. Patrick's Church pastor, will preach. Various priests will assist with the services. The council choir will sing motets directed by Mrs. Clay Britton and accompanied by Mrs. William Morgan organist.

### Visiting Bishop

Archbishop Schulte will speak, pronounce the invocation for the luncheon session and a blessing at the close of the convention. The Most Rev. Leo Pursley, D. D., auxiliary bishop of Ft. Wayne, will give the principal afternoon address. Others to be heard include: Mrs. Gerald Bennett, Grand Rapids, Mich., national president of the NCCW; and Mrs. George Moser, New Albany, archdiocesan president, who will give the president's message and preside. Mrs. John A. Murphy, deanery president, will welcome the delegates.

Departmental groups, each with a priest as moderator and a woman chairman, will meet in the forenoon April 9. Groups will discuss organization, libraries, literature study clubs, missions, the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, Census, Youth, press, publicity, rural life, welfare, legislation, history and retreats.
