Convention TV Plans Set Here

WFBM-TV will carry about 20 hours each of the Republican and Democratic national conventions to be held in Chicago during the month of July.

The station will pick up the CBS telecast, which is being sponsored by Westinghouse for about \$3 million. No definite schedule has been arranged.

Other systems telecasting the conventions include NBC, whose sponsor is Philco, and ABC, with the Admiral Corp. paying their tab.

John B. Huarisa, executive vice president of ABC, said that Admiral also will broadcast and televise election day returns on Nov. 4 as part of a \$2 million package agreement.
