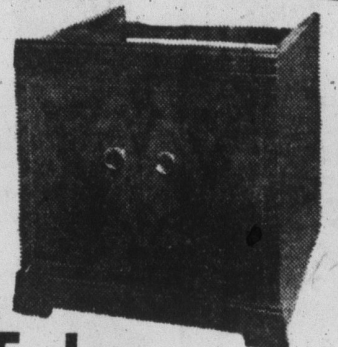

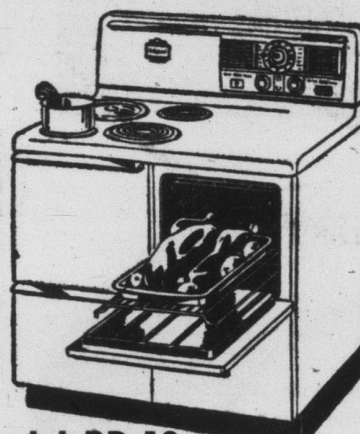

GI Slaying Case Goes to Jury

The fate of cafe owner Edwin Husbands, charged with fatally shooting a Camp Atterbury mess sergeant last June 29, was in the hands of a Criminal Court jury today.

The jury began deliberating at 10:30 a. m., after receiving 43 instructions from Judge Saul I. Raab. It recessed at noon for lunch.

In a surprise move, Husbands' attorneys declined to make a final argument to the jury of seven men and five women.

Husbands faces a possible life sentence if convicted of second degree murder in the shooting of Sgt. William Jagloski, 28th Division GI, in Eddie's Cafe, 401 E. Washington St.

The cafe owner, who did not testify, based his case on self-defense. He told police he shot the soldier when Sgt. Jagloski started to lunge at him following a fight with three other servicemen.
