The managers, ushers and attaches of the theater resisted the attack as best they could but were overpowered.

The night policeman were then called and a general fight took place. Finally a riot call was sent in, the fire bells were rung and the firemen rushed to the theater, turning the water on the college boys and flooding the principal part of the opera house.

After the students had been put out of the house stones were thrown, one breaking out a front window at the playhouse and another injuring policeman Scott Davis.
