IS THERE  
CHANCE FOR  
DARK HORSE

Latest News from Indianapolis Shows That Senatorial Lightning May Strike in One of a Dozen Places.

DARK HORSES KEEP  
ALOOF, HOWEVER

All Regular Claimants For Democratic Senatorial Are Declared to Have Made Extravagant Predictions As to Their Strength Which Are Ridiculed.

Indianapolis, Ind., Dec. 28. — There are some democrats who believe that there is to be chance for some of the dark horses that have peeped into the race for United States senator, and they are saying that when the time comes for a vote to be taken in the caucus there will be at least a dozen men, any one of whom may receive the lightning stroke.

There is, of course, the half dozen "regular" candidates which must be reckoned with first of all. This list includes Kern, Slack, Shively, Monzies, Lamb and Hoffman.

Others Are Named. The six other men whose names have been mentioned as possibilities in the race are: Samuel M. Ralston of Lebanon, Dan W. Simms of Lafayette, Marion Niblack of Vincennes, Stokes Jackson of Greenfield, Henry Warrum of Indianapolis, and Thomas W. Kuhn of Richmond. All of these dark horses, however, are holding themselves aloof from the campaign for the place, and

they have all said that they are not candidates. But any one of them might be persuaded to change his mind if things looked good to him.

Kuhn Mingles in City. A few days ago Kuhn was in this city mingling with the democratic statesmen, and while here he declared that he was not a candidate for senator. But he did not say that he was not framing things up to land the nomination for governor two years hence, and there are many democrats who are looking with favor on him for that nomination.

It is said that the recent developments in the race have given some of the dark horses new hope, however, and that they will probably do a little more looking around before the thing is over. All the regular candidates have made extravagant claims as to their strength, but everybody knows that no candidate at this time has enough votes at his command to win out. It is declared by all that there have been no combinations fixed up and that each candidate is working for himself alone. And it has not yet been proved that any combinations have been formed. Even the brewers seem to be keeping out of the fight as an organization, though each brewer has his man individually.

## Many Ballots Expected.

Unless conditions change within the next few days there will be a long continuation of balloting in the democratic caucus before a senator is chosen. Under such circumstances there is no telling but that the lightning may strike one of the dark horses.

It is also believed that no candidate will be able to swing his entire vote to any other candidate when the break comes. This also, is giving some hope to the friends of the dark horses.

The use of voting machines received a severe jolt in Bartholomew county when Judge Hacker of the circuit court refused to grant a recount of the vote of P. J. Kelleher, the democratic candidate for state statistician.

Machines were used at the election in Bartholomew county. In one pre-

dicting the machine showed a difference of about 140 votes between the vote for Kelleher and the vote for the other democratic candidates for state offices.

Kelleher's vote being that much below the others, Kelleher filed a petition for a recount of the vote of the machine, but Judge Hacker de-

cided that there was no law authorizing the recount of the vote as shown on the machine.

He said there was no way to get at the individual ballots cast by the voters. On the other hand,

Judge Demster of the circuit court in Marion county granted a recount of the machine votes in this county.

Whether there is any law authorizing such a recount will probably not be determined until the question has been determined by the supreme court.
