



of Bela Kun, the Red director, has not
been officially confirmed, the entente
delegates, acting on semi-official ad-
vises, sent a memorandum to the new
Socialist government which is said to
have been set up in Buda Pest.
It was informed that, if the Hun-
garians lived up to the terms of the
Austro-Hungarian armistice, the
blockade and all economic restrictions
would be lifted and the allies would
enter into actual peace negotiations
with Hungary as soon as possible.
