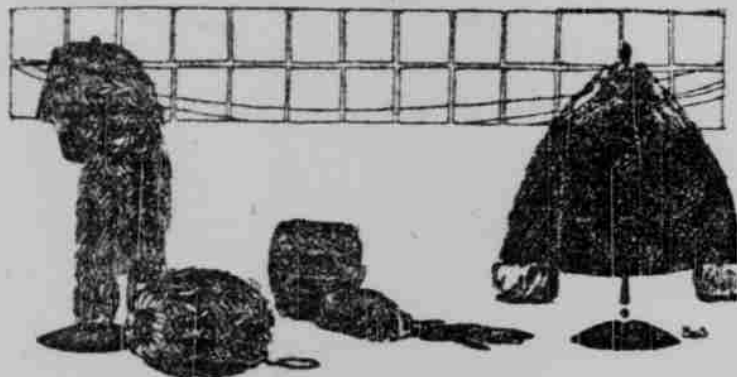

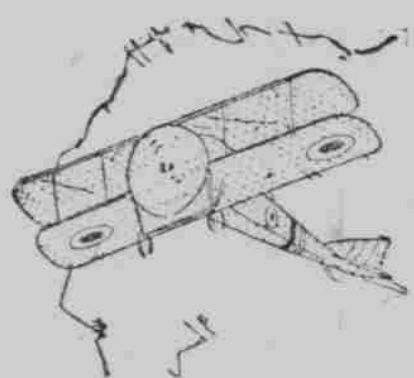

PARIS, AUGUST 3.—The peace conference today took definite steps to enter into peace negotiations with Hungary.
