CHICAGO, Feb. 13.—Six members of a "post office ring," charged with robbing mailmen and the widows and other dependents of Yanks killed during the war were arrested here today. It is believed the amount stolen will run in excess of \$100,000.

According to the post-office the six belong to a ring believed to be operating in every large city of the U. S. They are alleged to have a system for stealing soldiers' bonus checks, insurance payments, allotments, for injuries and A. E. P. death payments from the mails.
