

KIDNAPING CRIME STIRS WHOLE NATION

Maximum Penalty Demanded
by California for
Brutal Crime

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 1.—When
Arthur J. Carr and Floyd Carr, kid-
nappers of Mrs. Gladys Withers,
beautiful young Hollywood matron,
are sentenced by Superior Judge
N. Reave, at 9:30 o'clock tomor-
row morning and immediately rushed
to San Quentin prison, there will
be written the final chapter in a crime
of such sensational character that it has
stirred the whole nation.

The Carrs, who are cousins, entered
pleas of guilty to a charge of kidnap-
ing and attempted extortion. One of
them wanted a brief delay before go-
ing to prison, to attend to some prop-
erty matters and through public de-
fender Angeler, their request was laid
before Judge Reave, who agreed to de-
lay passing sentence.

The terms faced by the Carrs is from
ten years to life imprisonment, and in
view of the inflated temper of the
southern California people, together
with the thundering demands of the
public and press for a drastic lesson to
law breakers, it is predicted that the
maximum penalty will be imposed.

While large crowds thronged the vic-
inity of the county jail last night and
early today there were ample forces of
police reserves and deputy sheriffs to
handle any emergency and no riotous
outbreaks were feared.

While still suffering from the hard-
ships of her long and trying ordeal
when abducted from her home early
last Thursday evening and taken to a
lonely cabin in a canyon, 51 miles east
of Los Angeles, where she was rescued
at 4:30 a. m. yesterday, Mrs. Withers
was resting comfortably today at
the home of her father-in-law, A. J.
Withers.

The Carrs were in a state bordering
physical collapse as they crowded in an
inner cell at the county jail this morn-
ing. Both seemed nervous and under-
great mental stress and a constant
watch was being kept over them by
extra guards. A heavy force of guards
was also patrolling the outside of the
building. The prisoners were scorned
and jeered by the other jail inmates.

Several of the kidnappers in this vic-
inity have formed themselves into a
dairy association and will employ a
competent man to come and test their
cows. The idea is a good one and they
will in this way be able to find out
which of their cows is good and which
is bad. The association held a meet-
ing here yesterday afternoon and
elected the following officers: Presi-
dent, Forrest Grimes; vice president,
W. A. Alsworth; secretary-treasurer,
W. A. Clark; directors at large, Otto
Bayer and Ed Reddick. The meeting
was well attended and much work was
done. The work of testing the cows
will begin in a few days.

OPPOSES VACCINATION.
CHICAGO.—To the Editor, Sir: During
the "smallpox scare" which our
health board is engineering, it is
pleasing to note that the best-informed
means of preventing the contamination
of the blood of their children by
vaccination.

Every parent who takes a deep in-
terest in this question and all who
can should go to the public library and
get Prof. Alfred Russell Wallace's
great work, "Our Wonderful Century,"
a book of nearly 600 pages, in which
more than 100 pages are devoted to
the study of vaccination and smallpox.
Prof. Wallace says: "I affirm that vac-
cination is a gigantic delusion, that it
has never saved a life, but that it has
been the cause of much disease, so
many deaths, and vast amounts of un-
necessary suffering, that it will be de-
stroyed by coming generations among the
greatest of their age, and its present en-
forcement the foulest blot on the generally
beneficent course of legislation during
our century."

To prove absolutely that there is
nothing either preventive or tending to
lessen the severity of smallpox, I
will cite Japan, with every last little
dog vaccinated from one to several
times, according to who under the cur-
rent enforced vaccination law every
five years after twenty years of this.
