WATER MEETING IS HELD AT E. CHICAGO

Edward Winsor who is in Indianapolis and conferred with the governor at the same time that committee from East Chicago, Indiana Harbor were there, it is more likely that the commission will be held in Hammond.

A. P. TAYMAN TALKS.
